FOOTSTEPS OF PAUL

Cruise/Tour + Optional 3-Day Rome Extension

October 22 - November 4 or 6, 2024

Day 1: Departure

Overnight flight departing from Portland (PDX).

Day 2: Arrive in Athens

Arrive at the Athens Airport. Transfer to our hotel where we will spend the

next two nights. If time permits, we will take a bus tour of Athens. Breakfast and dinners in Athens are included at the hotel, lunches are on your own.

Day 3: Corinth & Port of Kehries

We will begin our day with a bus tour to Corinth. Along the way we will stop at the Corinth Canal and then continue our journey to the biblical city of Corinth, one of ancient Greece's most important port cities. We will tour the Agora, the Temple of Apollo, the Roman Odeon along with the Bema Seat where Paul stood trial before the Roman proconsul, Gallio. You will be amazed by the Acropolis and the view of the ancient Corinthian valley below. On our way back to Athens, we will visit the Port of Kehries, where Paul sailed for Ephesus. Lunch on your own at a local restaurant.

Day 4: Athens & the Island Princess

After a good night's rest, we begin our day with a tour of Athens, the foundation of democracy. We will visit the Acropolis, the Parthenon, and Erectheum before viewing Athens from atop Mars Hill. From here we hear a devotional from Acts where Paul stood and preached the Gospel to the Athenian philosophers.

Cruise Ship: Island Princess

Day 4: Cont'd - Board Our Ship

This afternoon we're off to the port of Piraeus to embark on the Island Princess cruise ship and continue our Footsteps of Paul journey. Enjoy all the meals and amenities offered on this modern and beautiful medallion class cruise ship.

Day 5: Mykonos

Our first stop will be the beautiful Greek island of Mykonos. We depart the ship in the morning and will be on our own to stroll the village streets, enjoy authentic cuisine, and take in historic sites like the famous Mykonos Windmills. Optional cruise excursions are available for you to reserve on your own.

Day 6: Day at Sea

This morning, we join together for a time of worship and a message from the book of Acts. Then, relax and enjoy the amenities of the ship as you spend a day at sea.

Day 7: Cyprus

We will arrive early at Limassol, Cyprus for a six-hour bus tour. Our excursion will take us along the coastal route to the ancient city-kingdom of Curium with its well-preserved mosaics, theatre, and basilica. We will visit the mythological birthplace of Aphrodite and then visit Pafos to view the mosaics in the house of Dionysos.

Next, we will visit St. Paul's Pillar, where it is believed that Paul was whipped by the Romans. We will stop at Yeroskipou on our way back to the ship and tour St. Paaskevi, a bascilla

surmounted by five domes which form a cross and has exquisite 15th century mural paintings.

Day 8: Rhodes

The island of Rhodes was famous for the Colossus of Rhodes and is one of the most popular destinations in Europe. Paul stopped in Rhodes on his third missionary journey. We will enjoy a walking tour of Lindos, a fortress used by the Greeks and Phoenicians, followed by a visit to the great palace and acropolis of the Grand Masters of Knight.

Day 9: Santorini

Today we stop at one of the most beautiful islands in the world. It's on the bucket list of many! Explore on your own or join a Princess excursion. It is a very accessible city and a beautiful place to explore on your own. The ship does not dock at a port here, instead we will disembark onto "tenders," the small boats from the ship that will take us to the island. Those with limited mobility will need to be extra careful or possibly stay onboard.

Day 10: Kusadasi (for Ephesus)

Today you visit Ephesus, the capital of Roman Asia Minor, and where St. Paul preached and taught for over two years. View the magnificent harbor and the great amphitheater which seated nearly 25,000 people. See Marble Street, the Library of Celsius, and the Temple of Hadrian. You will also see the Temple of Diana, one of the Seven Wonders of the World and the site of the scene of religious riots mentioned in the book of Acts. St. Paul had founded the Church here and was used of God to bring a major revival.

Day 11: Crete

Arrive in Heraklion, Crete, a beautiful Greek island, known for its famous archeological sites, stunning beaches, and lively town which is full of hidden treasures from the Venetian period. Today we enjoy a half day of excursions to the Knossos Palace and the Koules Venetian Fortress. Enjoy some time exploring on your own before our coach takes us to the port to embark again on our cruise ship.

Day 12: Day at Sea

We will come together again for a time of worship and teaching about the connection between the island of Capri and the life of Jesus Christ before enjoying another day at sea.

Day 13: Naples

You will have time to explore on your own southern Italy's largest city, Naples. Optional cruise excursions are available for you to re-serve on your own.

Day 14: Rome—Depart for Home or Optional Rome Extension

We will have an early morning arrival at the cruise terminal in Rome. Those who did not select the Rome Extension option will transfer to the airport and depart for the U.S.

Optional Rome Extension

Day 1: Catacombs, Coliseum, Roman Forum, Arch of Titus, & the Mamertine Prison

For those who opted for the Rome Extension, we will begin our tour of Rome with a visit to the Catacombs, where thousands of Christians were buried in a remarkable tiered series of galleries. Next, we will visit the Coliseum where thousands of people, animals, and Christians perished. The Coliseum first opened in AD 80 and within 100 days of its opening, 5,000 wild beasts perished there. Historians believe the Coliseum could hold between 40,000 and 80,000 people depending on how close the seating was arranged. The floor recently had a plank placed over the middle making it accessible for people to walk over the labyrinth of brick cells, ramps, and elevators used to transport animals and gladiators into the arena. Hear the stories of the games that have fascinated people for hundreds of years.

We will continue our tour at the ancient Roman Forum, where our guide will divulge its secrets. We will also visit the Arch of Titus which commemorated the fall of Jerusalem by Titus in AD 70.

We will then tour the Mamertine Prison exterior, where tradition holds that Paul was imprisoned in Rome.

Day 2: Piazza Navona, Trevi Fountain, Pantheon, Spanish Steps, Abby of the Three Fountains, Palatine Hill & St. Peter's Square

We will begin our second day in Rome with a downtown walking tour that includes the Piazza Navona, the Trevi Fountain, the Pantheon, and the Spanish Steps. Then we will visit the Abby of the Three Fountains, the traditional site of Paul's martyrdom for

he walked on. We will then continue to the Palatine Hill which is an open-air museum that housed imperial palaces and the nucleus of the Roman Empire. Next, we visit St. Peter's Square with an optional visit to the Vatican and Basilica. Enjoy some free time to explore Rome on your own.

Day 3: Depart for Home

We will transfer to the airport in the morning to depart for the U.S. and enjoy the memories of a trip of a lifetime!
